There is a fee of \$85.00 per presentation. We offer presentation series at a reduced cost: \$150 for two presentations, \$225 for three presentations. Most presentations are approximately 1 to 1.5 hours with time for Q&A afterward.



Training Program

The Master Gardener Volunteer Program is a nationwide educational program, and in New York State, consists of a corps of volunteers who are trained by Cornell Cooperative Extension in the science and art of gardening.

Master Gardeners are volunteers from the community who enjoy gardening, and use their horticulture skills and expertise to educate others. In return for their training, Master Gardener Volunteers donate their time teaching the community about gardening and the environment. Each volunteer agrees to give back 100 hours of service over a two year period, and then continue in the program as a certified Master Gardener Volunteer.
