- Protecting your birds from weather and predators

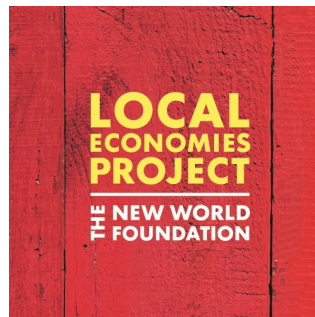
