Title: Energy Warriors Educator

Energy Warriors is an educational program of CCE designed to introduce youth presently residing in juvenile facilities of the Office of Children and Family Services (OCFS) to the science of Green Energy and sustainability. Youth who have successfully participated in the program upon release, work with the Reentry educator to connect through job placements, apprenticeships, further education and paid internships to the Green job sector.

Responsibilities: Responsible for implementing the delivery of the training curriculum at each OCFS site. Energy Warriors educators will promote program objectives and plans to OCFS staff and youth. Additionally, Energy Warriors educator will assist the Program Coordinator in activities to promote the program to local community leaders and discover best practices for successful program delivery.

Qualifications:

- Bachelor's degree plus 4 years' relevant transferrable experience. Masters preferred.
- Familiarity with program areas highly desired.
- Prior work experience in the legal profession and/or corrections is preferred.
- Ability to implement, teach, and evaluate informal educational programs.
- Demonstrated ability to manage resources.
- Knowledge of or ability to attain knowledge of county needs and the services provided by other agencies that relate to the program area(s) in communities where youth may be returning.
- Ability to adapt to changing needs and handle multiple projects simultaneously.
- Able to work effectively with people of varying backgrounds.
- Ability to meet travel requirements associated with this position.

Hours/Benefits: Position is part-time (30 hours/week) and includes full benefit package including health and dental insurance, retirement, life insurance and more.
