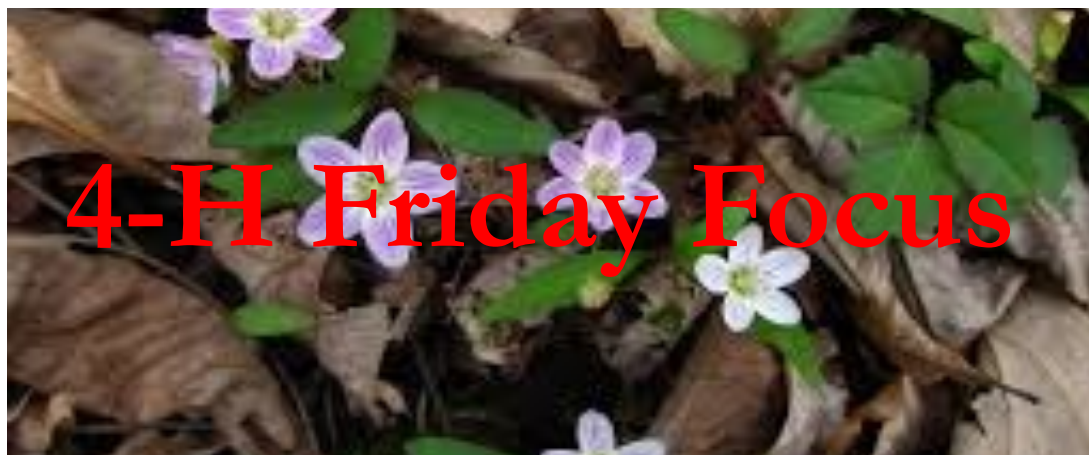

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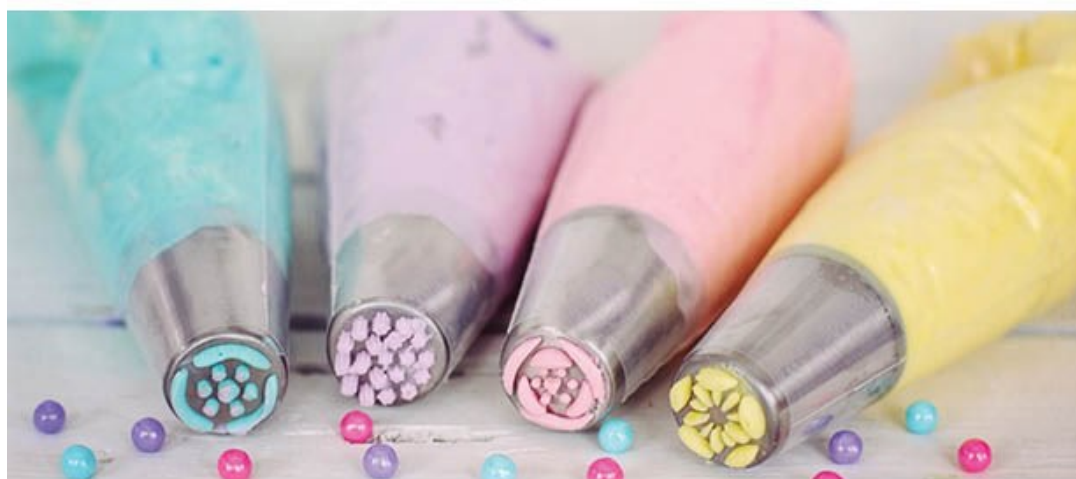
4-H Friday Focus

Survival Skills Challenge



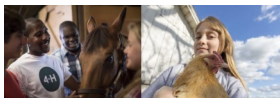
Imagine you're lost in the woods—what will you eat, how will you prepare a shelter, how will you stay warm?

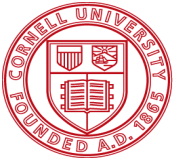

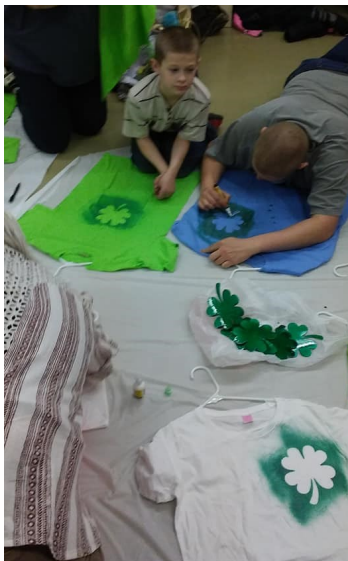
