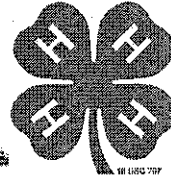

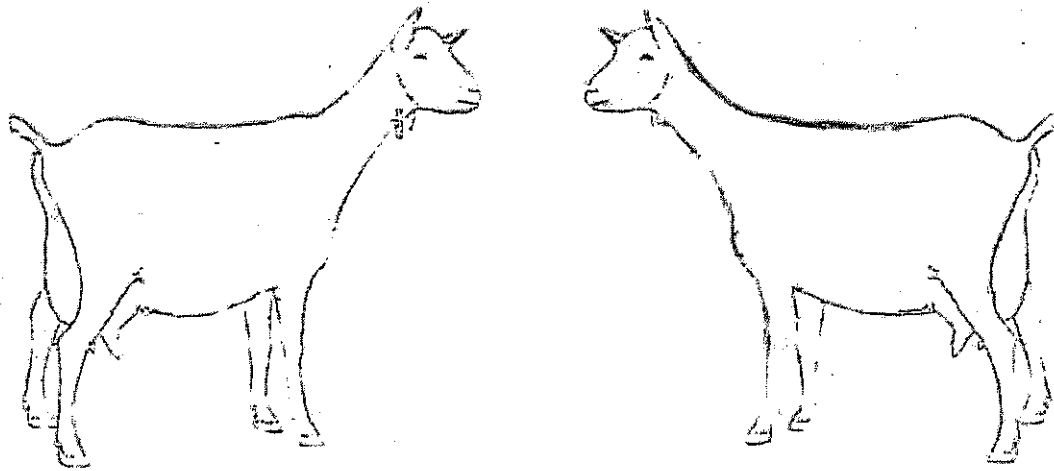

- It is suggested that goats receive a rabies vaccine and you must have a health paper in order to come to the fair.

Health papers may be issued from May 1, 2019 on and they will be valid for the fair.

Please remember that there is a withholding period on the rabies vaccine and it must be administered at least **21 days prior to their arrival at the fair if administered to a meat goat going through the auction.**
