#### **May 1 | Getting into the Food Business | 2 – 4 pm | FREE**

New York Ag & Markets and NYS Department of Health in Sullivan County will review food licenses and permits, and help you decide what's right for your business. Topics include basic food safety, determining what products need testing, Better Process Control School, and home food production. #### **May 1, 8, 15 | Horse Lovers Intro to Horses | 3:30 – 5:30 pm | \$35/youth or \$30/4-H'er\***
