Title: Regional Transportation Project Educator

Responsibilities: The Regional Transportation Project Educator will provide leadership to a groundbreaking project covering seven counties in Upstate New York. This innovative project utilizes Way2Go's transportation education resources and expertise in order to address regional transportation needs for accessing health care and employment. The Educator will work with community leaders across the region and collaborate with these partners to develop easily shared outreach tools and informational materials. The Educator will act as a subject matter resource on regional transportation issues for regional partners, decision makers and community members.

Qualifications: Ability to initiate, plan, organize, implement, teach, and evaluate informal educational programs. Ability to network and build relationships with a diverse group of community members and stakeholders while maintaining cultural competency.
