If any adult would like to trim before that evening around the 4-H building, contact the 4-H office. **Please no open toed shoes.**

In addition to fair clean up night, the fair volunteers and board members are working every Monday night and Saturday until fair week. If you have time to attend one of these workdays, your efforts would be very much appreciated. This would be a nice way for 4-H'ers to support the fair.



4-H FUN DAY!

We will be hosting a 4-H fun day at Roseland Water Park on August 5th. Thanks to the 4-H paper clover campaign, we are able to offer this fun-filled day at a rate of \$15 per person for the first forty-five 4-H members, leaders, and parents/siblings that register. After we have reached 45 registrations, the rate will increase to the standard group rate of \$21.95. Non-4-H friends and extended family are welcome to join and are eligible for the \$21.95 group rate.

NOTES FROM THE FAIR BOARD IN REGARDS TO THE FAIR

1. We have spoken with the state vet and it is our understanding that there will be 3 vets on site when we are unloading animals this year so it should go a bit smoother.
2. The Fair Board members and volunteers have built an area in the Dairy and Beef Barn for 4-H animal exhibitors to store food during the week. All food must be labeled that is stored there. There will be refrigerator space, a microwave and lots of outlets for electrical appliances.
3. There are still lots of renovations going on at the fair grounds on Saturdays. If you want to volunteer on behalf of the fair board at some of their workdays, it would be greatly appreciated. This is not connected with 4-H but to support the fair board and all they do for our youth members and the community.



OVERNIGHT AT THE FAIR –

THERE WILL BE NO SLEEPING OVERNIGHT IN THE BARNs AT THE FAIR. It is not allowed by our insurance company and is in the rules of both 4-H and the Fair Board. If you want to stay at the fair, there is camping available for both campers and tents.
