



Dear 4-H Families:

New to the Re-enrollment and Enrollment process for the 2019-2020 4-H year we are asking families and **volunteers** to enroll and re-enroll themselves in 4honline.com. This is a change from previous years. This change will allow you to have regular access to updating your information, receiving information and to ensure that your information is current and correct.

We realize that lack of internet access may be a barrier for some families and will provide opportunities for families to meet with staff to use internet at events and open nights at the 4-H Building during the enrollment time-frame. There are also step by step directions available to help assist you in enrolling.

In addition to enrolling online, members will still need Code of Conduct, Medical Release, Photo Release and Acknowledgement of Risk forms signed and handed into the office. These forms can be found on your 4honline.com home page with you first log in, on our website, in Thursday things. These forms must be hand signed and provided to the office via scan, mail or in-person.

What is next:

If you are currently enrolled and will be re-enrolling, we ask you to:

- Visit ny.4honline.com, select *I forgot my password*
- Enter the email you receive Thursday Things through
- Select *Send My Password*
- Check your email for a new temporary password, be sure to check your junk mail folder!
- Log in, update your password and keep the new information handy for future use!
- Update information and re-enroll!

New families can visit ny.4honline.com and begin the registration process by selecting *I need to setup a profile*.
