# Genesee County Open 4-H Gymkhana Horse Show Rules & Fees

## *Fees*

*\$6 per class (all divisions)  
\$20 per stall, \$10 refund if stripped  
Please make checks payable to "CCE Genesee"  
\$20 service charge for returned checks  
No refunds for scratched classes.*

## *Divisions*

*Walk/Jog - Any 4-H rider 8-14 years of age in their first or second year of riding  
(\*Walk/Jog riders cannot cross enter into Youth or Open Divisions)  
Youth - Any 4-H rider 8-18 years of age  
Open - Any rider 18 years and older as of January 1, 2020*

## *New York State 4-H Horse Show Rules*

- New York State 4-H Horse Show Rules apply to all participants, regardless of age.*
- Complete NYS 4-H Horse Show Rules can be found at <https://4h.ansci.cornell.edu/>*
- Youth riders (age 8-18) must be currently registered 4-H members and show proof of rider evaluation from their respective county or a letter from their Cornell Cooperative Extension Office indicating they are enrolled in the county's 4-H Horse Program.*
- All participants, including adults, must sign the Acknowledgement of Risk Form (parents to sign for youth).*
- All participants must wear approved helmets and proper equestrian footwear.*
- Non-4-H members under eighteen (18) years of age may not participate in gymkhana events.*
- Proper attire & tack are required.*
- A current negative Coggins (2019-2020) and current Rabies Certificate (1 year from show date) for each horse must be presented at registration.*
- Horses outside the ring must be ridden at a walk.*
- The show management's decision is final. Disputes & questions are to be brought to the show committee.*
- The show committee reserves the right to cancel or combine classes.*
- Proceeds to benefit the Genesee County 4-H Horse Program.*
- Youth riders may cross enter into Open Division. Walk/Jog riders may not cross enter.*
