# **Genesee County 4-H Open Pleasure Horse Show Rules & Fees**

### Fees

Open: \$8 per class
Youth or Walk/Trot: \$6 per class
Leadline & Walk/Halt: Free
\$20 per stall, \$10 refund if stripped
Please make checks payable to "CCE Genesee"
\$20 service charge for returned checks | No refunds for scratched classes

### **Divisons**

Walk/Jog - Any 4-H rider 8-14 years of age in their first or second year of riding (\*Walk/Jog riders cannot cross enter into Youth or Open Divisions)

Youth - Any 4-H rider 8-16 years of age

Open - Any rider 8 years and older as of January 1, 2020

Must have a minimum of 2 entries in each class in order to run (except classes 13-15).

Participants in class 13 or 14 or 15 may not enter in any other class.

## New York State 4-H Horse Show Rules

- New York State 4-H Horse Show Rules apply to all participants, regardless of age.
- Complete NYS 4-H Horse Show Rules can be found at https://4h.ansci.cornell.edu/
- All participants, including adults, must sign the Acknowledgement of Risk Form (parents to sign for youth).
- All participants must wear approved helmets and proper equestrian footwear.
- Proper attire & tack are required.
- A current negative Coggins (2019-2020) and current Rabies Certificate (1 year from show date) for each horse must be presented at registration.
- Horses outside the ring must be ridden at a walk.
- The show management's decision is final. Disputes & questions are to be brought to the show committee.
- The show committee reserves the right to cancel or combine classes.
- Proceeds to benefit the Genesee County 4-H Horse Program.
- Youth riders may cross enter into Open Division. Walk/Jog riders may not cross enter.
