Redeeming your FMNP Coupons

- Coupons come in booklets of 5, each coupon is worth \$4
- Coupons must be used in \$4 increments. You cannot receive change
- If your purchase is not equal to \$4, the farmer will add produce to equal \$4
- Look for vendors with the FMNP poster, or ask if they accept FMNP
- Both Senior FMNP and WIC FMNP coupons are accepted by participating vendors
- Only fresh fruits and vegetables can be purchased with FMNP coupons

Using SNAP Benefits to Shop at Farmers' Markets


- Visit the Market Manager to swipe your EBT card
- The Manager will give you wooden tokens in the amount of money you charged to your card
- Most tokens are \$1 each, some are \$5
- You cannot receive change for your tokens, so farmers will round the amount of product to equal whole dollars
- Look for vendors with EBT signs, or ask vendors if they accept EBT tokens
- Only approved products can be purchased: Vegetables, fruit, meats, eggs, cheese, dairy, processed food (jam, pickles, etc.), culinary herbs, & spices, mushrooms, baked goods/bread, maple syrup, honey, vegetable transplants, fruit trees
- Not allowed: ornamental plants, crafts, prepared foods
