



**Cornell Cooperative Extension of Onondaga County-
Volunteers and Program Participants Code of Conduct and Assumption of
the Risk Relating to Coronavirus/COVID-19**

Code of Conduct:

By attending CCE Onondaga events, volunteers and participants agree to follow CCE Onondaga rules for protecting yourself and others from transmission of Covid-19. For outdoor events, you will wear a face cover if within six feet of another person and not spend more than 15 consecutive minutes within six feet of the same person. For indoor events, a face cover will be worn at all times and not spend more than 15 consecutive minutes next to the same person. If you have conditions that prevent you from wearing a face cover, please speak with a CCE representative to see if accommodations can be made. I acknowledge that CCE Onondaga has the right to refuse entry to an event or the right to expel me from an event if they have determined that I am not abiding for this code of conduct or, an accommodation cannot be reasonably made.

Acknowledgement of Risk:

I understand Cornell Cooperative Extension of Onondaga County (“CCE”) has put in place preventative measures to reduce the spread of COVID-19; however, CCE cannot guarantee that I or any of my contacts will not become infected with COVID-19. If I become infected with Covid-19, I will accept the responsibility for the exposure to myself or my child and will indemnify and save harmless CCE Onondaga from any responsibility for the infection or consequences. I acknowledge that I have reviewed the plan for Cornell Cooperative Extension of Onondaga County. I will abide by the guidelines and continued updates as released by NYS Forward and the CDC.
