- We have included your pre- fair horse certificate form, fair registration forms. We follow State Fair rules for Horses. They can be found on the state website at http://ansci.cornell.edu/animal-program/horse/equineshow-rule-book/. Rule book is set up so you can print off the sections you will need for classes you will enter.
- Due dates for each form are stated in red.
- Project records books and all pre-fair and fair forms will be available on the 4-H webpage at http://allegany.cce.cornell.edu/4h-youth-development as well as in the 4-H office.
- Project Record Books are designed so that you work with them throughout the duration of your project, and not at the very end. Please plan your time wisely in order to get the most from this fun and rewarding opportunity!
- Please be aware your horses name need to match on both coggins and rabies certificates.
- Project Records and Portfolios will be due into the office by Friday, September 17th.
- Reminder: Due to the COVID-19 virus, we ask 4-H'ers and parents to please practice social distancing of 6 feet or wear a mask and wash your hands with warm water and soap for a least 20 seconds or use alcohol based hand sanitizer.


