As you all know, due to COVID-19, 4-H Camp Wabasso was not able to operate as normal for the 2020 camp season. Instead, we offered the 4-H Camp Wabasso Adventure at Home camp-in-a-box program. This program was so well received that we are continuing it throughout the school year! What better way to stay connected with camp, than to do camp-themed activities with your family at home?

The next round of camp-in-a-box is a CSI themed box that will be delivered in time for the February school break. This box is full of over 10 hours of hands-on camp activities. This box will teach youth participants

how to solve The Mystery of the Stolen Wand using forensic analysis. Activities will include chromatography, fingerprint analysis, facial recognition, forensic chemistry, and more! The box will also include a traditional camp craft and a camp t-shirt and tie-dye kit.

The camp-in-a-box program is most suited for youth ages 6-16. The cost is \$50 and includes shipping and all the materials and instructions to do over 10 hours of hands-on 4-H camp activities. Internet is not required, but we will provide a google classroom with video instructions for each activity as well. To conclude the camp-in-a-box program, we will hold a virtual campfire through Zoom! We encourage all youth to participate in the virtual campfire where we will tie-dye our t-shirts together, play fun group games,



sing camp songs, and tell campfire stories.
