



Open Summer Camp Positions, 2021

Day Camp Director: Responsible for designing and leading Day Camp Program for 5-8 year olds. Ability to supervise children. Ability to supervise assigned staff. *Requirements: Minimum age 18. College degree desired. Appropriate First Aid and CPR.*

Young Women's Adventure Camp Specialist: Plan & implement a program using traditional camp activities to stimulate discussion around issues facing girls entering 6th & 9th grades. Program offered two weeks. Opportunity to work as a Senior Counselor the remainder of the season. *Requirements: Minimum age 21. Three seasons of camp experience. Appropriate First Aid and CPR. Current driver's license.*

Camp Clerk: Managing the camp store, including daily sales, inventory management, and weekly deposits. Also responsible for procuring supplies related to the operation of camp. *Requirements: Minimum age 21. Valid Driver's licence and successful completion of a motor vehicle background check.*

Camp Nurse: RN. Supervise and enforce relevant NYS Department of Health standards. Work with Administrator, Director, Caretaker, and staff to provide safe physical health conditions for all. *Requirements: Minimum age 21. RN License. Appropriate First Aid and CPR.*

Counselor-In-Training Specialist: Train and supervise older campers interested in developing leadership skills & working at a camp in the future. Implement the CIT curriculum and work with the Leadership-in-Training program staff as well. *Requirements: Minimum age 18. Appropriate First Aid and CPR. Experience working in a camp setting.*

Class Specialist: Positions available for Specialists in Shooting Sports (Archery and Riflery) and Ropes Course. Teach concepts related to class. Modify lesson plans to meet campers needs and interest. Ability to lead and guide assigned counselors. Experience in and knowledge of assigned class concept. Responsibilities to includes serving as a Senior Counselor in the afternoons and evenings. *Requirements: Minimum age 18. Appropriate First Aid and CPR. Archery Specialists are required to have Instructor Certification acceptable to Dept. of Health. Camp will provide these trainings.*



Lifeguard/Counselor: Assist in teaching ARC swimming lessons; Lifeguard for special classes and activities. Lifeguards also serve as a counselor (see below). *Requirements: Minimum age 17. Lifeguarding, First Aid and CPR Certifications.*

Counselor: Experience in working with children, ability to teach a specific program and ability to supervise children in an outdoor setting. Responsible for a cabin of campers and for leading a class. *Requirements: Minimum age 18. Appropriate First Aid and CPR desirable.*

Assistant Counselor: Experience in working with children, ability to assist with classes under the supervision of a senior counselor or specialist. Assist in aspects of kitchen operations including food preparation and clean up. Assist with cabin supervision. *Requirements: Minimum age 17. Appropriate First Aid and CPR desirable.*
