The 2021 - 22 Project Year Meeting Protocol

In person meeting requirements:

- Parents must complete the health evaluation for their youth on the event/gathering attendance form .

Zoom meeting requirements:

- c. due to technology, your home IP may not support multiple zoom users on individual devices. We are certainly okay with multiple participants on a single device.**
