#### COST:

Total Cost: \$225 per youth

NOTE: Non-Putnam 4-H Members should check with their home county to see if they are providing any partial scholarships to attend this retreat. Otherwise Youth Participants will be expected to pay full cost of Retreat which is \$225.00

#### **COVID Guidelines:**

- All participants, including chaperones, must provide negative COVID test results within 3 days of the retreat. \*Note: An additional Rapid Test may be re-quired 24hrs prior to event depending current COVID guidelines.
