RUBE GOLDBERG CHALLENGE

LET'S BUILD SOMETHING CREATIVE!

THIS YEAR'S GOAL IS TO WATER A PLANT!

GUIDELINES:

 Machine must have a minimum of 7 steps and a maximum of 15 steps. A single step is defined as a transfer of energy.

Examples:

- Ball rolls down a ramp and springs a mousetrap
- The mousetrap pulls a string causing a scissor to cut
- · The scissors cut a cord, causing a weight to fall
- Weight drops on tin foil, causing light bulb to turn on
- At least 3 of the steps must use a simple machine (lever, screw, gear or wheel and axle, pulley, inclined plane, or wedge)

Rube Goldberg Machine is a chain reaction-type machine or contraption intentionally designed to perform a simple task in an indirect and overly complicated way. Usually, these machines consist of a series of simple unrelated devices; the action of each triggers the initiation of the next, eventually resulting in achieving a stated goal.

This contest is free and open to all youth in Orange County ages 5-19 as well as all Orange County 4-H youth members.

If you are a teacher, 4-H Club leader, or other youth leader in Orange County, you can register the youth in your class, club, or group.

We will mail a packet of five sunflower seeds and growing instructions for each registered youth later this month. For teachers, 4-H Club leaders, and other youth leaders, we will mail you individual packets of seeds for the total number of youth you register and let you distribute them.

The seeds should be planted between June 1st and June 15th. We will follow up with you throughout the summer. Your flowers will bloom in late August and September. Contest submission can be made online from September 1st through September 30th. More details to come. Prizes will be awarded to youth for the tallest plant, largest bloom, etc.
