

## State Revolving Funds Support for Stormwater Solutions

- 1. Is obtaining external funding essential to accomplish your capital projects?
- 2. Do you need help preparing successful funding applications?

If you answered **Yes** to any of these questions, then the Center for Watershed Protection can help you! CWP has engineers and professionals with experience to assist you in writing successful applications and administering funding after award. CWP staff can:

- Prepare funding applications including developing concept designs, writing project narratives, developing budgetary cost estimates, and calculating nutrient reduction.
- Prepare disbursement request forms.
- Track the contract amount, the various funding sources and amount spent from each source.
- Review certified payroll versus the required wage rates and perform payroll interviews.
- · Review American Iron and Steel documentation.
- · Review and track Women and Minority Business Participation.
- Complete the Self-Certification form to accompany Disbursement requests.
- Write grant progress reports.

## Did you know?

- The Federal Bipartisan Infrastructure Law will be provided through the State Revolving Fund (SRF) program. Do not miss out on this funding source due to a lack of SRF administration experience!
- Clean Water SRF projects include stormwater, water reuse, watershed projects, and nonpoint source pollution management.
- SRF allows for 3% Administrative fees. CWP's fees for administration are eligible for the Administrative fee allocation and can be included in the grant/loan.
