DURING THIS AGREEMENT:

- -The owner and member will decide on the housing, feeding, vet care, and expenses involved, and who pays for them.
- -Parents must support this agreement and provide transportation as needed for member and/or animal.
- -The member must attend all 4-H meetings and complete fair and 4-H responsibilities during this agreement.
- -4H Member must meet owners at farm as necessary to care for animal or complete other farm/animal tasks as decided by animal owner
- -Animal may be shown by 4-H member listed within this agreement at shows approved by owner.
- -If the criteria is not met, the agreement is void.
- -This agreement may be terminated at any time if owner feels the criteria is not being fulfilled.
- -Please provide a signed copy of this form to your animal key leader
- -It is recommended that a signed copy is also kept with animal owner and 4-H member for their records
- -Leased/loaned animal may not participate in the 4-H livestock auction
