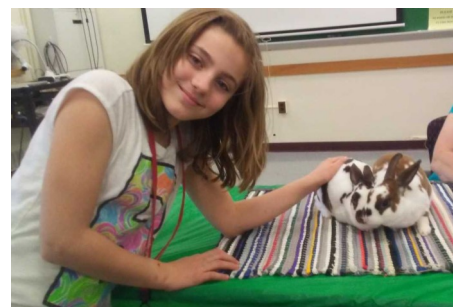

2023 Animal Crackers “All Creatures Great and Small” Dairy, Sheep, Poultry, Rabbit/Cavy

The Cornell University Department of Animal Science is pleased to announce 2023 Animal Crackers, "All Creatures Great and Small", on Saturday, May 6, 2023, on the Cornell University campus. This year's program will highlight Dairy, Sheep, Poultry, Rabbit/Cavy topics. 4-H youth 8-12 years old or those with beginner to intermediate knowledge of the covered species are invited to participate.

Interesting, educational, hands-on activities are planned to make Animal Crackers a memorable learning event. Participants will have the opportunity to learn about Dairy, Sheep, Poultry, Rabbit/Cavy, biology, and management while having fun participating in a variety of interactive activities, with 4-H'ers from across NYS.

Registration: There is a \$20 per youth cost to attend the program - adult chaperones are free. Attendees are asked to bring their own lunch. Registration for the event must be done through your local Cornell Cooperative Extension Office and must be completed no later than April 24, 2023. All groups must have at least one chaperone. 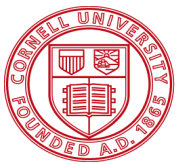
