All 4-H Youth:

- o Must be enrolled in 4-H no later than May 1, 2023 to participate in 4-H Classes of the fair.
- o All Project Animal certificates are due to the CCE Lewis office NO LATER than JUNE 1, 2023.

Horses	(for closed show and fair): Horse Animal ID certificate for each animal Valid Rabies and Coggins through 9/15/23.
Cattle:	Dairy Cattle Animal ID Certificate for each animal Valid CVI, BVD Test and rabies vaccine USDA approved 840 RFID tags recommended. Please see the NY Ag and Markets requirements for more information.
Goats,	Sheep: Scrapie Identification-approved tag or tattoo. Sheep only: rabies vaccine
Poultry	: Negative Pullorum Test or certification that the bird comes from a certified pullorum free flock. Pullorum Testing is scheduled for June 21 at CCE Lewis. Please RSVP to attend.
Dog:	Must have proof of rabies vaccination.
