BEEF

On average, a steer from our sale will yield 65% freezer fill to live weight.

Thats 50lbs of sirloin steak from a 1,250lb steer!



PORK

On average, a hog from our sale will yield 75% freezer fill to live weight.

Thats 20lbs of bacon on a 250lb Hog!



LAMB

On average, a lamb from our sale will yield 75% freezer fill to live weight.

Thats 11bs of loin on a 100lb lamb!



CLUB SUPPORT


A select group of items and baskets will be available in the sale to support our non-animal clubs. These may be baskets, pies or flowers!
