



Junior: Youth who are at least 8 years of age by January 1st of the current club year and in the third grade or higher should enroll as a 4-H member. Juniors must not have reached their 14th birthday prior to Jan 1st of the current club year.

Senior: Seniors must be at least 14 years of age by January 1st of the current club year. Youth who have reached their 19th birthday before January 1st of the 4-H club year may not enroll as a 4-H member.

RULES

- All classes will be judged according to the NYS 4-H Competition Events Rules except where stated otherwise.
- Participants must wear proper attire including footwear (no 'fat babies' or boots without a heel) and ASTM-SEI protective headgear (5 years old or newer).
- An 'Acknowledgement of Risk' form must have been signed and be on file at the 4-H office or signed at the day of show for insurance purposes.
- Judge's decisions will be final.
- Negative EIA test (2022-2023) and current Rabies vaccine required.
- Riders must have successfully completed a riding evaluation if they are new to 4-H or are moving up to the next level (i.e. walk, jog to walk, jog, lope) or jumping for the first time. Evaluations must be done by a staff member .
- No dogs are allowed on site per city
- Age requirements on back side.
