Guidelines on Use of Minor Names and Images in 4-H Youth Development



Print Guidelines - Name Identification

NYS 4-H Youth Development follows the Cornell University Communications practices regarding the use of a minor's identification:

- You may use the first and last name of a minor, and reference their hometown, in news articles
 recognizing achievement or highlighting an event. A good example is a newspaper article,
 State Fair or County Boards and newsletters, or the Cornell Chronicle. A minor's first and last
 name may be used in this instance.
- Youth and volunteers' <u>addresses and phone numbers should not</u> be posted.
- Youth email addresses should not be posted.
- You must have a current, signed, parental consent release form on file with your county office if the article you are posting contains an image of one or more minors (see Images/Photos guidelines below).
- Club information should be "general" and <u>should not include individual names, phone numbers, addresses, and/or towns.</u>
- If you are listing the first and last name of a minor in an article that is intended for 4-H
 marketing or promotional purposes such as brochures, flyers, websites, blogs, Facebook and
 other social media, you must have a signed parent/legal guardian release form on file in your
 county office.

Print Guidelines - Images/Photos

NYS 4-H Youth Development follows the Cornell University Photography practices regarding the use of a minor's photograph or other image:

- If you use a photograph or <u>image of any minor</u>, for either *recognition* or *promotion*, and the said minor(s) face is clearly visible (side or frontal view), you should have <u>a fully executed (signed by parent/legal guardian) photo release form on file with your county.</u>
 - This **photo release form** must be on file with your county office and/or identification imbedded within said image, prior to publication.
 - Parties submitting photographs to the NYS 4-H office, should **send photos with the associated release form.** Photos without a release will be returned.
