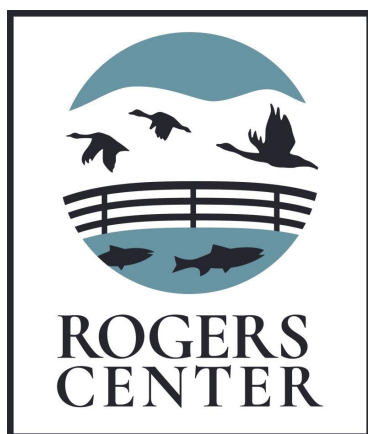


National 4-H Week

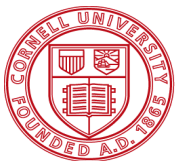
