4-H Re-enrollment Season is Here!

Each year in October we are required to re-enroll all 4-H youth and volunteers. Most of our families have become familiar with this process, however, we are making some pretty significant changes this year, primarily in that all families are now encouraged to re-enroll using the 4-H Online System. Folks are still welcome to request paper enrollment forms.

There will be an informational Zoom meeting on Monday, October 2nd at 6pm to walk through the re-enrollment process. You should have received an email with the link to this meeting. Please contact glb76@cornell.edu if you need the link resent. This meeting will be recorded and a link will be shared with all families so that they can reference as needed. Please feel free to join the live meeting to ask any questions about this process.

Though online re-enrollment is being encouraged, we will still need to collect hard copies of all forms and payment. If you are in a 4-H club, please contact your club leader to see how they would like to collect these forms and payments. If you are an individual, you can find all of the required forms at our website: ccesaratoga.org. Just look for "Re-Enrollment Forms" on the left side bar on the 4-H Youth page. Please note that if you are re-enrolling online, you will not need to submit the actual enrollment forms, just the forms notated below.

DEC Hunter Education Course Saturday, October 14th

It's Fall... and hunting season is upon us. If YOU plan on hunting, remember, first time hunters in New York State MUST take and pass a Hunter Education course. Similar courses are also required for bow hunting and trapping. A certificate from the appropriate course is required in order to purchase a license. Hunters must be at least fourteen to hunt big game with a firearm and twelve for bow hunting. Bear in mind, twelve year olds may hunt small game

There will be a DEC Hunter Education Course on Saturday, October 14th from 8:00-4:00 at the 4-H Training Center. This course is open to youth and adults. To complete the course, students must be present for the entire in-person course on 10/14, and students will have to retrieve a workbook and homework sheet from the CCE Office. Homework must be completed and submitted the morning of the course.


