## STEUBEN COUNTY HORSE 4-H POINT SYSTEM FOR ANNUAL HORSE SHOW AWARDS

A member must show the same horse in 1 of 2 qualifying shows plus 4-H Showcase in order to be eligible for any of the following awards.

Walk/Trot and Novice ribbons will be awarded the Danish system. Points will be awarded on numerical ranking in the class.

Non-owners, as per state rules, are eligible for year-end awards. Points will be awarded based on actual class placing.

**1. YEAR-END HIGH POINT AND RESERVE AWARDS**: For Walk/Trot and Novice, high point or reserve high point awards may only be won once per exhibitor/horse combination. For Junior, Senior or Pony, the high point and reserve high point awards may be won every year. Member(s) winning multiple categories may receive a combined award.

For each show, rank class winners of 1st-5th will be awarded points as follows:

 $1^{st} - 6$ ,  $2^{nd} - 4$ ,  $3^{rd} - 3$ ,  $4^{th} - 2$ ,  $5^{th} - 1$ . In Danish classes with more than 5 exhibitors, the points awarded will reflect the number showing. (ex. 7 riders =  $1^{st} - 8$ ,  $2^{nd} - 6$ ,  $3^{rd} - 5$ , etc)

The highest score for the overall show at either qualifying show will be used to calculate points when members participate in both qualifying shows.

**HUNT SEAT DIVISION:** These awards are based on placings in Showmanship in Hand, Equitation, Pleasure, Hunter Hack, Equitation Over Fences, Working Hunter and English Trail classes when offered at the best qualifying show, plus 4-H Showcase.

**WESTERN DIVISION:** These awards are based upon placings in Showmanship In Hand, Equitation, Pleasure, Road Hack, Command, Horsemanship and Western Trail classes when offered at the best qualifying show, plus 4-H Showcase.

**GAMES:** High point and reserve awards will be given in Walk/Trot, Novice, Junior, Senior and Pony divisions and will be based on all games offered in that level.

**DRIVING:** These awards are based on the horse/driver combination with the most accumulated points in Showmanship In Hand, Reinsmanship, Pleasure and Obstacle Driving classes.

**VERSATILITY AWARDS:** High Point and Reserve Awards will be given in Junior, Senior and Pony divisions. These awards are based on placings in English Pleasure, Western Pleasure, Trail, Straightline Barrel, and Pleasure Driving. Youth/Horse combination must compete in at least two different seats or disciplines in at least one qualifying show plus 4-H Showcase to be eligible for these awards.

**2. PRIVATELY SPONSORED AWARDS:** Please contact the CCE Office if you'd like to sponsor these awards. **Sunny Award:** given to veteran 4-H horses that have been 4-H mounts for various 4-H riders. This is a perpetual trophy and has the names of all the honored horses on its faceplate. It is in memory of Sunny Weather.

**Cowboy Memorial Award:** given to the horse & rider combination with the most points accumulated over the summer show season.

**Most Improved Rider:** These awards are provided by the individual clubs to recognize their most improved rider.

**Most Improved Over Fences:** based on Equitation Over Fences, Hunter Hack, and Working Hunter classes. Not necessarily based on accumulated points, but on the progression of the horse and rider. Junior or Senior riders eligible.

**Sportsmanship Award:** Sportsmanship awards are provided by the individual clubs to honor those members exhibiting superior sportsmanship.

**3. DRESSAGE:** An award will be given for the top two tests overall at County Fair.

## HIGH POINT and RESERVE AWARDS for the June and July shows:

A high point and reserve high point awards will be presented for the following horse and exhibitor combination. In the event of a tie, equitation/reinsmanship will be used to break the tie.

HUNT SEAT AWARDS – Awards will be given for Walk/Trot, Novice, Junior, Senior, and Pony Divisions based on Showmanship, Equitation, Pleasure, Hunter Hack, Equitation Over Fences, Working Hunter, and English Trail.

WESTERN AWARDS – Awards will be given for Walk/Trot, Novice, Junior, Senior, and Pony Divisions based on Showmanship, Equitation, Pleasure, Road Hack, Horsemanship, Command, and Western Trail.

GYMKHANA AWARDS – Awards will be given for Walk/Trot, Novice, Junior, Senior, and Pony Divisions based on Showmanship, Keyhole, Cloverleaf, Straightline Barrels and Pole Bending.

DRIVING AWARDS – Showmanship, Reinsmanship, Pleasure, and Obstacle.

MINIATURE HORSE AWARDS – Showmanship, Trail, Hunter, Jumper.
