

1. Always ask an adult before you approach a horse.




- Horses can kick. Don't walk behind them.
- Always <u>walk</u> towards a horse—don't <u>run</u>.





- Always wear boots around horses to protect your feet.
- Check the cinch on your saddle before you mount.






