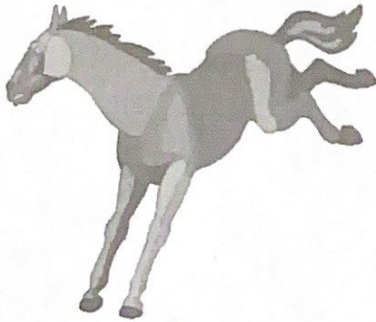




# Horse Safety Rules

2. Horses can kick. Don't walk behind them.

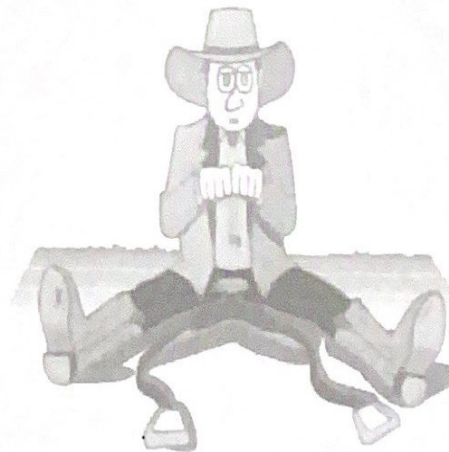
3. Always walk towards a horse—don't run.

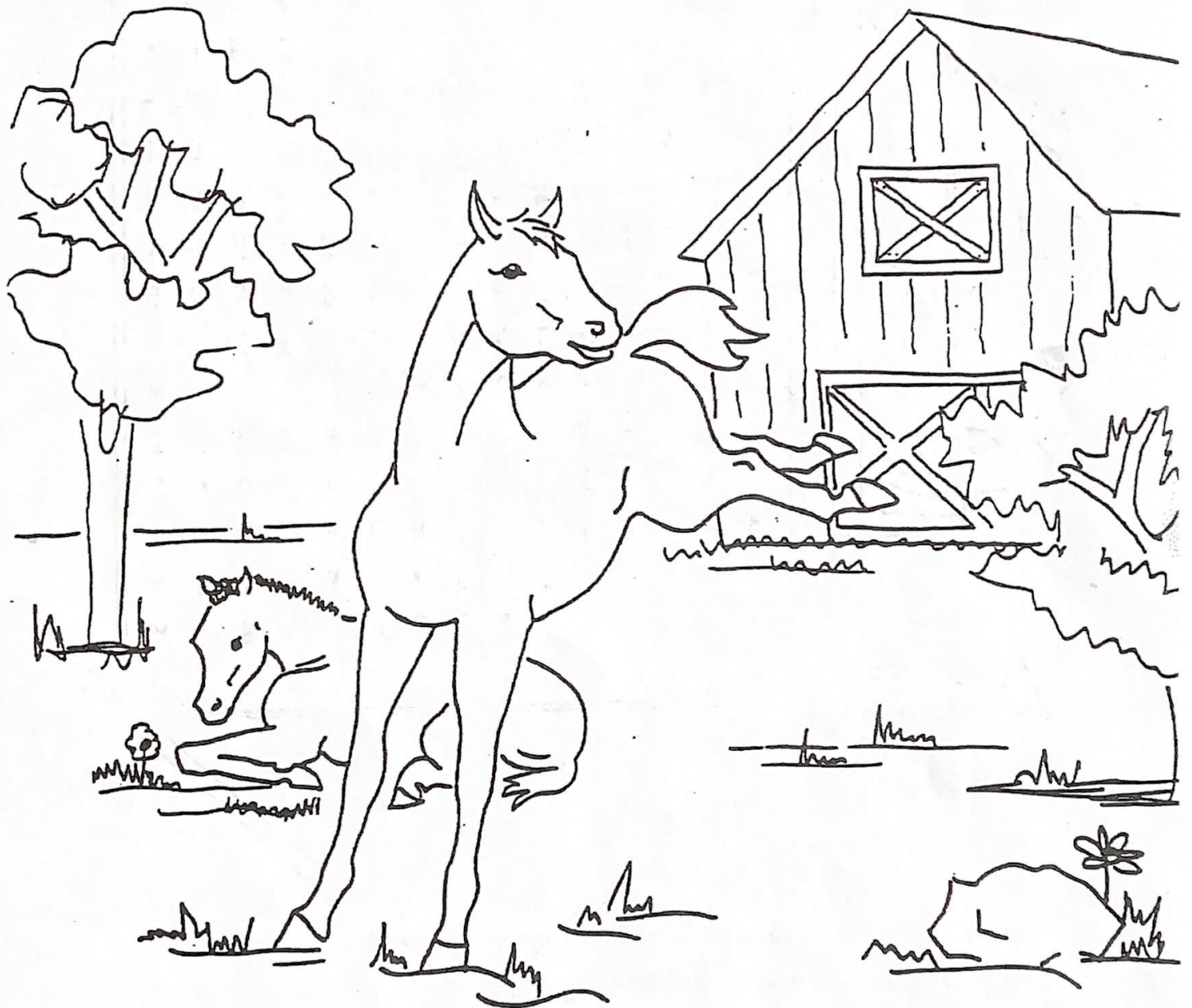

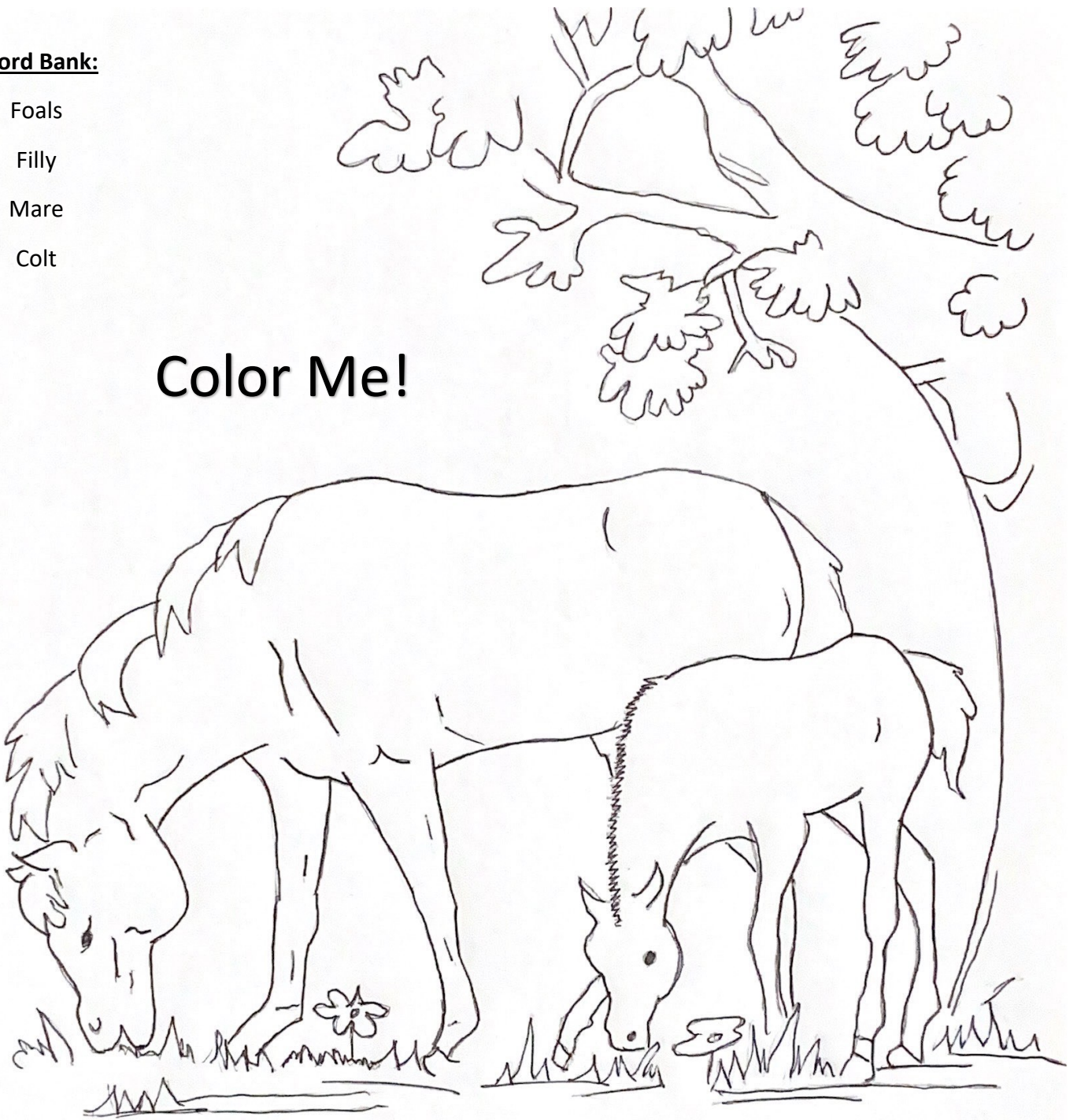

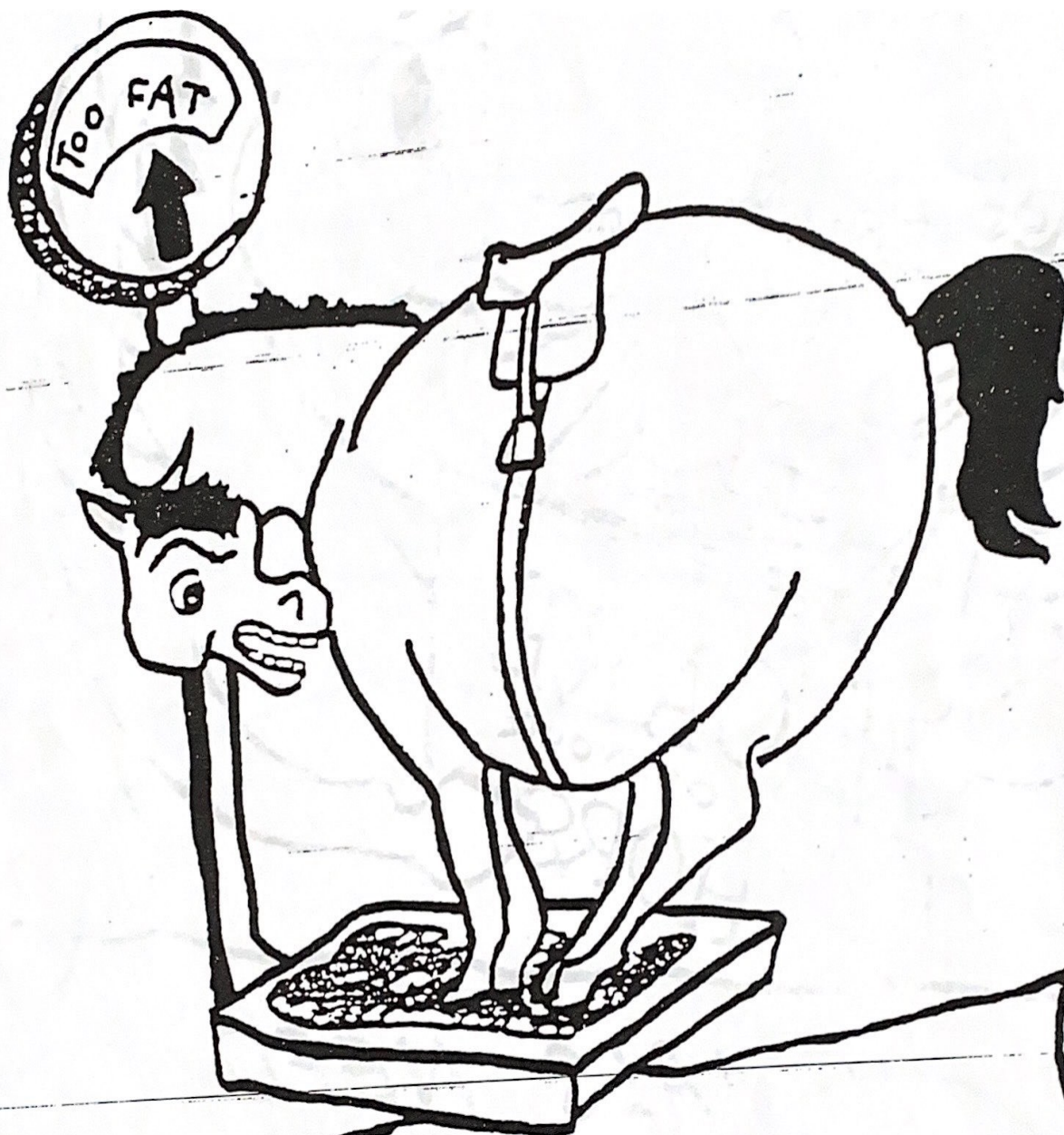
