Completion of entries by the June I deadline, July I for poultry only. Failure to turn in entries by these times will result in inability to participate. Pullorum testing for poultry is set for July 9th at 5:30 pm.

The State Vet will be providing us with a training video to help youth prepare livestock for fair and make participants and families aware of health-related requirements as well as issues that will result in an animal being sent home. Please watch for more details, watching this informational video will be required for fair participation.

Market Auction:

The next Market Auction required meeting is Wednesday, April 10, 6:30 pm at the Ed Center. The topic will be project records and forms. If you have a project record in progress, please bring it with you.

Market Auction weigh-in is the weekend of May 4 and 5, 9 am—I pm. Sign-ups will be at the April 10 Market Auction meeting.

Market Auction Baked Goods: Any 4-H program/club who would like to participate in the baked good category of the 2024 Orleans County 4-H Fair Market Auction may enter. There are only six spots available, one per club or group. The split of the proceeds will be 50/50 between the club/program and the market auction program. Items must be prepared in the Trolley Building kitchen. Items must also have the approval of 4-H educator in determining the size or quantity of the lot. Items will not be evaluated. To register email Kristina. If less than six groups express interest those group who do wish to participate may be able to sell a second lot, and will be contacted with that opportunity.
