YOUTH BUILDING EXHIBITS

All youth building exhibits must be entered and judged on FRIDAY, AUGUST 8TH!

Judging Hours will be 1PM to 7PM. Exhibits to be judged on Friday include: Clothing, Home Improvement, Food, Booths, Flowers, Vegetables, Woodworking, Photography, Woodworking, Natural Resources, STEM, etc.! Refer to the department H sections 14-20. Vouchers must be properly filled in before coming to the fair. Double entry cards must be completely filled out and securely attached to exhibit.

If youth are unable to be present for judging (health reasons, work, etc.) exhibitors must call the 4-H office by Friday, July 25th to make special arrangements to enter items on Saturday, August 9th between 9AM and 11AM.

PICK UP EXHIBITS: Saturday, August 16th between 4PM and 8PM in the Youth Building or premium money may be forfeited. Additional pick up hours of Sunday, August 17th 12:00-2:00pm.

Think, write and plan which exhibits you want to bring to the fair this year!

Fill out your paperwork BEFORE you bring your exhibits to the fair for evaluation!

- Voucher (one per 4-H member)
- · Double Entry Card for each item entered, attach securely to exhibit
- Evaluation Sheets for Clothing, Arts & Crafts, Fine Arts, Handyman, STEM, Photography will be using the universal evaluation sheet. The self reflection portion will need to be filled out before evaluation day. Refer to the fair book if you need to fill out one sheet per CLASS or per DIVISION depending on the exhibit type.
- A separate universal evaluation sheet for FOODS will be utilized. The first page also needs to be filled out prior to evaluation day.

Call the 4-H office if you have questions on which class to put your exhibits.

Fair books are available for free in the office!!

Evaluation Day is the Friday before the fair starts - August 8th! You will check in all of your items, and wait in line to have your exhibits judged. Judging will be from 1-7pm.


The 1st place blue ribbon booth will receive an additional \$15, 2nd place \$10, and 3rd place \$5.



The Wyoming County 4-H program does allow cloverbuds to exhibit small animal projects (poultry, rabbits and cavies) and leadline horses at the Wyoming County Fair. These projects should be animals that the youth members own and care for on a regular basis, beginning by at least June. Cloverbuds who wish to bring a small animal to fair can choose one poultry animal, one rabbit/cavy, or one each of poultry and rabbit.

Cloverbud exhibitors will bring their project animals to fair just like older exhibitors on the day their species arrives and house them at the fairgrounds for the entire duration of the fair. Cloverbud members will be expected to care for their project animals each day at the fair. Depending on how many entries we receive, cloverbuds may be asked to take animals home after the show.

When it comes time for showing cloverbud small animals, keep in mind there is no competition. This opportunity is provided for cloverbuds to be able to experience bringing small animals to the fair, caring for them, and learning about how to show for the future. On show day for each particular species, cloverbuds will have the opportunity for a "mock show" where they will do showmanship with a volunteer. In order to prepare for this, we highly encourage each cloverbud exhibitor to attend a poultry or rabbit club meeting/showmanship clinic.

Cloverbud exhibitors <u>WILL NEED</u> to fill out a regular animal fair entry form and turn in to the 4-H office by July 15th. Please contact the 4-H office with questions or for more details.

- 1. An opportunity for all 4-H members to participate and showcase their baking and/or decorating skills.
- 2. Limit one item per 4-H member. Select one of the following choices: Cake or pie must be completely homemade, no premade mixes, fillings,crusts or frostings!
 - Cake (decorated or specialty cake)
 - Pie (no cream pies)
- 3. 4-H'er must be present at the auction to showcase their baked item. Because cakes and pies cannot be brought into the barn arena, 4-H'ers must make a poster and/or have a photo to market their baked item while in the arena during the auction. Baked goods will be on display in the youth building the evening of the auction.
- 4. Only 10 spaces are available for participation! Pre-register is required by calling (585-786-2251) by July 15th.
 - Upon registration, please submit to the 4-H office the following information:
 - 4-H'ers name, address, email and phone number
 - parent's/guardian's name
 - club name (if applicable)
 - name of baked item, a picture of the baked item, product description
- 6. Baked item must be entered by 3pm Wednesday, August 13th, in the Youth Building at the Wyoming County Fairgrounds in Pike, NY. Windowed cake/pie boxes will be provided by the 4-H Office for auction items and will be put on display in the Youth Building prior to the live auction, between 3-5pm on Wednesday evening. Please note that the pans and plates used for your baked item will not be returned. You may also wish to include recipe for the baked item, if you wish. All participants are asked to meet in the Youth Building at 8:15 p.m. on Wednesday evening, in preparation for the auction.
- 7. 4-H participants are encouraged to solicit their own buyers for the Wyoming County 4-H Cake & Pie Auction by personally contacting potential buyers and/or by mailing potential buyers an invitational letter to the auction. A promotional flyer will be available from the Wyoming County 4-H Family & Consumer Science program to help in these efforts!
- 8. 4-H Cake & Pie Auction will take place at approximately 9:00 p.m. in the new Ag Expo Center arena at the Wyoming County Fairgrounds in Pike, NY. The Cake & Pie Auction will take place at the conclusion of the meat animal auction, after the dairy steer sale.

Auction procedure:

- 1. Sale order numbers will be assigned by a random drawing and will be attached to the baked item.
- 2. 4-H'ers will line up according to number assigned to their baked item.
- 3. Due to health and safety concerns, the cakes and pies will **not** be brought to the Barn Arena and will stay on display in the Youth Building during the auction. 4-H'er will hold up pictures/posters depicting details of the baked item during the bidding process.



- 4. Buyer will pay for the item with the auction cashier.
- 9. All proceeds from the sale of the auctioned cake or pie items will benefit the Wyoming County 4-H Family and Consumer Sciences Fund to be used to support FCS projects and activities including the FCS Scholarship, Produced in NYS Foods Contest, Clothing Revue, International Food & Fun Night/Delicious Destinations event, Youth Building renovations and a variety of other workshops and activities.
 - Reminder: No cream fillings or perishable ingredients! Due to hot weather, we need to be aware of food safety issues for all 4-H supporters buying baked items. Please follow this simple guideline in order to ensure the future of the Wyoming County 4-H Cake & Pie Auction at the Wyoming County Fair.

New York State Fair Teen Leadership Opportunities 2025

Wyoming County's Time Period is Saturday August 23rd - Wednesday August 27th

State Fair will be here before we all know it and plans are in place for many exciting activities to take place this year in the Youth Building! Wyoming County 4-H is looking for teens (13 years and up by January 1, 2025) who would like to help out with our Wyoming County interactive display in the Youth Building during Wyoming County's time period at State Fair. Teens will stay at the State Fair dorms and will receive a premium of \$12.00 per day to offset expenses. Youth, ages 9 – 12 yrs., are eligible to serve as Youth Leaders and help in our county booth but must be accompanied by an adult. Youth Leaders who work a minimum of 3 hrs., will receive a premium of \$6/day.



Booth decorations and "make it and take it" projects will focus around hands-on, interactive projects and will be determined by mid-July. As we did last year, Wyoming County will be sharing a booth exhibit space with Western New York Counties, with all seven counties exhibits on display for the entire State Fair duration.

Other opportunities at State Fair for youth (13 years and up by January 1, 2025) include:

- ➤ <u>Teen Evaluator/Judges Helper:</u> gives teens the opportunity to gain a better understanding of the evaluation process, teens bring exhibits to the adult evaluator's station, assist with evaluation, write comments, attach ribbons and comment sheets, return exhibits to county display booths. Areas include foods, clothing, art objects, home environment/child development/consumer education, communication & expressive arts, horticulture, STEM, & visual arts (photography).
- **Science and Technology:** teens will help showcase the various renewable and sustainable energy 4-H projects being undertaken in NY State. (4-H energy bike, high tech bio-fuel stoves, 4-H solar units, etc.)
- ➤ GPS/GIS Science Teen Leader: demonstrate how 4-H offers youth real life learning experiences through 4-H Geospatial Technology, showcase completed 4-H GIS and GPS Science projects, help the public learn about 4-H Community Mapping projects, and so much more!
- **Poultry & Avian Sciences:** responsible for the entire maintenance of the exhibit. This includes care of the numerous live animal displays, operation of the commercial incubator, clean-up, paper-work and interaction with fair-goers.
- ➤ <u>4-H Shooting Sports:</u> responsible for the presentation of the 4-H Shooting Sports Program via the laser shot, interactive project activities, and displays, along with the care and maintenance of the exhibit space.
