



Stop Cutting Grass Too Low:

Grass should be maintained and mowed at 3-4" which will hold stormwater by allowing root systems of healthy turf to absorb runoff.

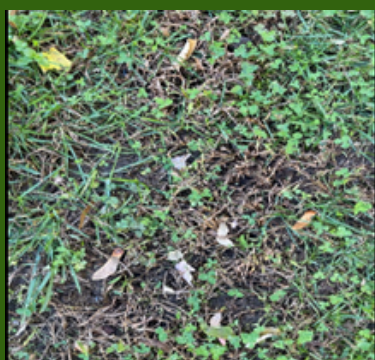
Excess phosphorus from sediment is a major water quality issue and a contributor to algae blooms
