Our educator will provide **FREE** products and resources, which may include:



- **Home Safety Products:** smoke detectors, radon test kits, carbon monoxide detectors and fire extinguishers
- Child Safety Products: cabinet locks, electrical outlet covers, stove knob covers, doorknob covers and corner protectors
- Asthma Control Items (in conjunction with education program)
- Cleaning Supplies: bucket, mop, baking soda and vinegar
- Safety Products: flashlights and nightlights
- Pest Management Products
