Our educator will provide **FREE** products and resources, which may include:



- **Home Safety Products:** smoke detectors, radon test kits, carbon monoxide detectors and fire extinguishers
- **Child Safety Products:** cabinet locks, electrical outlet covers, stove knob covers, doorknob covers and corner protectors
- **Asthma Control Items (in conjunction with education program)**
- **Cleaning Supplies:** bucket, mop, baking soda and vinegar
- **Safety Products:** flashlights and nightlights
- **Pest Management Products**
