New York State 4-H Esports is an initiative that connects youth ages 13 and up through online gaming while promoting teamwork, critical thinking, and digital citizenship. By meeting kids where they're at - in the digital spaces they already enjoy - we create opportunities for learning, leadership, and connection in a format that resonates with today's youth.

Goals

1. Foster positive spaces - both online and offline - where young people feel supported, included, and inspired.
2. Build life skills through structured play, tournaments, and educational programming while encouraging responsible gaming habits.
3. Provide youth the opportunity to connect with like-minded peers from across New York State.
4. Expand awareness and participation of this exciting new frontier in youth development, engage with a broader audience, and show how 4-H continues to evolve to support young people in every space they live, learn, and play.

Registration and Premium Information

1. Youth must be 8 - 18 years of age to participate in this program, and will receive an Exhibitor Premium for participation.
2. Registration must be completed either online or in-person prior to youth competing.
