- 2) Do not repeat items within the report form. Be concise but descriptive.
- 3) Use phrases beginning with verbs to describe all activities.
- 4) List all information with your first year in 4-H listed first through current year.
- 5) Designate local (L), county (C), district (D), state(S), etc. instead of writing out.
- 6) Leadership, public speaking and community service are important in all areas.
- 7) Projects are broad subject matter areas where members learn skills, do activities and make items. Activities are things done usually with a group or as part of a group.
SAMPLE: Activity -car wash, food booth, bake sale
Project -yeast breads, electricity, swine
- 8) Reports should be stapled and should **not** be put in any folder or report binder.
