- Orange County Executive's Office Paul Wiley
  - County bought the Old Chester School for \$1
    - Possibly tech training center (beyond BOCES)
    - Maybe adult education center

- Schunnemunk Trail being expanded
  - Camp Laguardia → 2 miles should be cleared after camp
  - Similar to Heritage Trail

## **Committee Reports:**

- Personnel Committee Amy Minutolo
  - No updates; committee met 4/16/25
- Finance Committee Tom Manza
  - January gain \$37K → No SNAP contract yet
  - o Expenses were down due to open positions
  - o Did not receive appropriations until March

- February gain \$33K
- Revenue down because SNAP grant wasn't executed yet
- o Expenses were down due to open positions
- Program registrations increased \$15K
- Travel/Lodge increased \$4K due to SNAP conference

  - Tom felt we have a good finance committee
  - Most things discussed we are already doing
- $\circ$  We received No-Till grant  $\rightarrow$  \$ was given upfront
- \$7.7K grant through SNAP-Ed → Rescued Eats
- Awarded Transportation Grant
- Fund Development Committee Nancy Proyect Rider & Amy Minutolo
  - Not doing HV Gives this year
  - Will have meeting next month
- Park & Facilities Committee Lucy Joyce
  - o DASNY 1
    - Equipment is arriving this week
    - Breaking ground next week

#### **Unfinished Business:**

- Old Dairy Barn-Town has 99-year lease with us  $\rightarrow$  They must maintain it.
  - Roof in bad shape → Tried to fund through Restore NY
  - o Town would like to give us the building after they repair it
    - Does CCE want to pay the difference for metal Roof? → 30 years vs. 100 years
  - Passed already by town board for \$60K
- Education Center
  - o \$150K for design from county for Education Center
  - o If county is buying, they need to own the building and property around it
- DASNY 2
  - o Top 2 priorities when starting
    - Insulate/Heat Kosuga
    - Tree Removal
