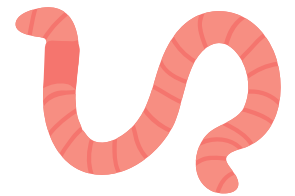
**Did you know as a soil amendment, compost helps to promote soil health, improving the physical, chemical, and biological characteristics of soil?**
