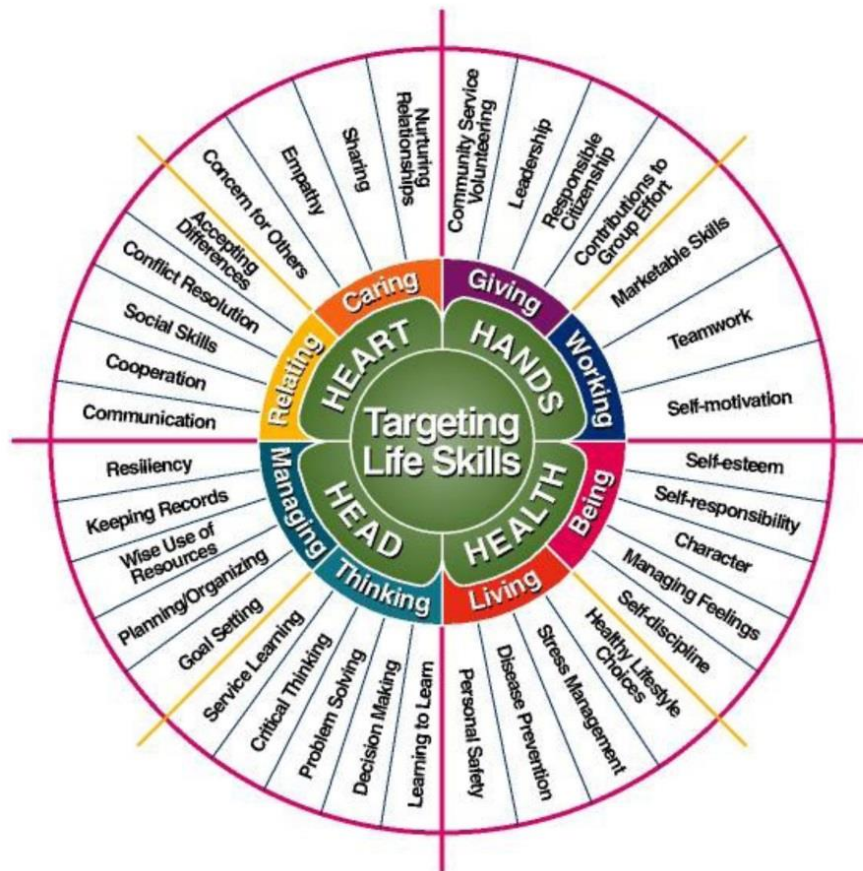

There must be 1 life skill from each of the 4 categories Head, Heart, Hands Health.
