Program Highlights

Direct Education Workshops & Outreach:

- Conservation Field Days, Sep 18: aimed at the 6th-grade youth, we will discuss the importance of agriculture and where our food comes from. Students from six different schools will participate in a "Local/Non-local Grown" activity to learn about the produce grown locally.
