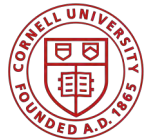

4-H Clubs are co-ed groups with at least five members, ages 5 - 18 years of age. The Cloverbud Program is open to youth 5 - 7 years of age.

Family 4-H is for 4-H members who do not belong to a club. They have an adult mentor and must complete at least one 4-H project and one community service each year.

National Lead Poisoning Prevention Week
October 19 - 25, 2025

Lead Renovation, Repair and Painting Program
Lead is highly toxic and exposure to it can be dangerous, especially for children who are 6 years old or younger. The greatest exposure to lead in our environment is lead-based paint found in homes and buildings built before 1978. Renovation, repair, or painting (RRP) projects in a pre-1978 home or building can easily result in lead dust that increases the risk of lead poisoning.

The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) requires that RRP projects that disturb lead-based paint in homes and child-occupied facilities built before 1978 be performed by lead-safe certified contractors. In November 2025, the new Lead Rental Registry Law is scheduled to go into effect in 25 communities of concern in New York, including Albany County. As part of the new requirements, pre-1980 housing with two or more rental units must be inspected and documented as free of lead paint hazards. Property owners, landlords, and contractors are highly encouraged to become EPA certified in RRP in advance of the new law taking effect.
