PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Service is a major component of 4-H. Did you know that April is 4-H National Service Month?

We encourage youth to brainstorm, select, and plan an initiative to give back in their community throughout the year. These initiatives don't always require funding, but sometimes a little funding is needed to make the project a reality or extend the project impact just a bit further. Through this program, independent member youth or clubs are eligible to apply for a grant of up to \$100 toward a community service initiative that they would like to complete.

In addition to benefitting the communities in which the project is completed, this program is a perfect opportunity for youth to be introduced to the process of goal-setting, budgeting, grant-writing, reporting, and more! These mini-grants will give 4-H members, leaders, and parents the opportunity to learn by doing and hopefully inspire others to take a more active role in their communities through service projects.

PROJECT ELIGIBILITY

To apply for funding, youth must be active/enrolled in Delaware County 4-H and working in collaboration with an active/enrolled 4-H Club Leader or Volunteer. Community service projects are defined as work completed to benefit others/community without compensation for services performed.

FUNDING AVAILABILITY

The number of awards given will depend on funding availability in the CCE Delaware 4-H Program budget and may vary year to year.

Please submit completed applications by February 1, 2026. Applicants will be notified in writing of the determination by February 15, 2026. Final reports on funded projects will be due by September 30, 2026.
