

4-H Re-enrollment Time!!

Each year in October we are required to re-enroll all 4-H youth and volunteers. Most of our families have become familiar with this process and as we have for the past few years we are encouraging families to re-enroll using the 4-H Online System. Folks are still welcome to request paper enrollment forms.

Though online re-enrollment is being encouraged, we will still need to collect hard copies of all signed forms and payment. Get Ready for Hunting Season! DEC Hunter Education Courses

's Fall... and hunting season is upon us. If YOU plan on hunting, remember, first time hunters in New ork State MUST take and pass a Hunter Education course. Similar courses are also required for bow nunting and trapping. A certificate from the appropriate course is required in order to purchase a ense. Hunters must be at least fourteen to hunt big game with a firearm and twelve for bow hunting. Bear in mind, twelve-year-olds may hunt small game. Students must be eleven years old or older.

ere are many DEC Hunter Education classes throughout our area. We highly recommend doing an inrson class rather than doing an online class. There is a lot of hands-on experiences offered in person nat cannot be replaced online. We are currently working on setting up a Bowhunter Education Class for late October.

these placings was out of 15-20 riders per class.


Amelia and Fuego have made us proud representing Saratoga County.
