➤ SNAP-Ed funding update: Congress has zeroed out the SNAP Ed funding in the 2025/26 budget. Senators are not accepting the entire bill, Unfortunately, senators are not focusing on SNAP benefits or Medicaid, so the possibility of staff being laid off is real. The Eat Well Play Hard and SNAP Ed budget was 1.3 million.

Outside hiring has ceased. We have transferred two Nutrition staff to Energy. Part-time staff member retired and other staff members have been looking for other employment opportunities. There is an opportunity in Ag program as a Farm Business Management since Michaela left for personal reasons.

SNAP Ed will continue until September 30, 2025.

We have another grant Staff Family Network which will entail two people at a later date.

We have been having open communication with the Nutrition staff and will meet again tomorrow. The staff from SNAP are giving us their future plans also.

The potential is a \$150,000 loss in administrative costs.

Finance Committee Update: We had a zoom meeting to discuss and feel that we will try one bank and two out of the three investment companies: Adirondack Bank, Morgan Stanley and Caruso & McLean. We will give the companies a year to see how well the accounts perform and to see what customer service we will be given. No policy is needed but review the accounts at least on a monthly basis.

- Last Tuesday, June 24, 2025, we had the preconstruction meeting. Ground breaking will start in three to four weeks from July 4, 2025.
