

# **Department 25 - STEM**

# A. Handyman/Wood Working

This woodworking project area includes categories for projects made entirely by hand tools, power tools, and kits with pre-cut materials assembled by the exhibitor. Additional classes cover leathercraft and rope projects, as well as Advanced Woodworking project for experienced participants judged at a higher level.

#### **B. Electrical**

These electric projects may include lamps or other wiring-based items, which are judged on safety, wiring accuracy, and completeness. Electronics projects must be hand-wired, functional, and neatly assembled, with exhibitors providing brief explanation of how the project works and its purpose.

#### C. Other

These classes include projects focused on energy conservation, electronics, and engineering science. Exhibits may demonstrate ways to save energy, feature functional hand-built electronic devices, or present three-dimensional educational displays.

# D. Engineering

- Includes projects in rocketry, model design (such as Lego, K'nex, or similar kits), mechanical science, 3D printing, engineering, geospatial science, and more!
- Entries emphasize creativity, technical skill, understanding of scientific or engineering principles, and clear presentation or documentation.
- Projects range from kit-based or original Lego builds to rockets, GIS mapping, renewable energy studies, and citizen science exhibits, all highlighting learning, innovation, and problem solving

# **Gingerbread House Community Service**

November is the month many of you will be making gingerbread houses for the Festival of Trees during Victorian Street Walk or for display at the Saratoga Library. In past years we have had incredibly creative structures such as: gingerbread schools, stables, castles, and yes, houses! We look forward to seeing new designs for 2025!

A gingerbread house display is a great community service opportunity for 4-H. It enables us to be an active member of a community event as well as being able to share the houses with local groups like senior centers, soup kitchens and nursing homes. The houses are first displayed at various locations during the Victorian Streetwalk, and then donated to local community centers for further display.

Information to help you participate in the gingerbread project:

- All houses need to be brought to the 4-H Office by Monday, December 1st.
- There are two gingerbread kits available to borrow. The kits contain instructions, equipment and supplies. Not quite everything you will need, but the hard to find items are there. Clubs can borrow the kits for one week. Please call the 4-H Office at 518-885-8995 to reserve a kit.
- IF your club is making a scene with multiple houses or other structures the board you place it on cannot be larger than 2' by 2'.
- IF your club is making individual houses or structures please place them on a sturdy base such as wood, foam board, or heavy cardboard. Please do not use a single piece of cardboard.
- Houses will be at multiple locations. We are still solidifying those locations. If your club is interested in staffing one of the locations, please call the 4-H Office.



# Time to Re-Enroll for Another Great Year in 4-H!

It's that time again! Each year, all 4-H youth and volunteers need to re-enroll to stay active in the program. Most families are familiar with the process, but we made some big updates last year — and we're keeping the momentum going!

#### Online Re-Enrollment Encouraged

We're now encouraging everyone to use the 4-H Online System to re-enroll. It's quick, easy, and helps us stay organized! That said, if you prefer paper forms, no worries — you can still request them.

#### What Still Needs to Be Submitted

Even if you re-enroll online, we still need signed hard copies of certain forms and payment.

- Club members: Check with your club leader to see how they'd like to collect forms and payments.
- Independent members: Visit <u>ccesaratoga.org</u> and look for "Re-Enrollment Forms" on the left sidebar of the 4-H Youth page.

If you're using the online system, you won't need to submit the full enrollment form — just the additional required documents listed on the site.
