3. 2026 County Allocations

- a. Otsego County
 - Allocation may be reduced by approximately 25%, Andrew Marietta explained the County's
 - financial situation and process
 - At the budget lab meeting regarding CCESO's allocation Liz requested restoration of at least
 - \$10 to \$15K
 - There is an Otsego County Budget Public Hearing is on November 25 at 6 PM in the Otsego Co Courthouse

b. Schoharie County

 At the Associaiton's budget hearing there was a motion to keep CCESO's 2026 Schoharie Co allocation level (\$290K).

4. Development Activities

- a. Grant Funding
 - SNAP Ed is currently funded thru 1/31/26, and once PY2025 financials are settled it is expected that the program will be funded thru 9/30/26 with surplus funding held by NYS OTDA.
 - HRI Small Wellness grant implementation is underway, approximately \$7,000 in funding based on deliverables.

b. Pending Funding

- Community Foundation of Otsego County grant submitted to support 2026 Seed-To-Supper + Grow A Row Expansion (+ nutrition education)
- Also submitted applications to support this to 2 small Ots Co foundations
- Rebab of the Otsego Education Center
- Renew America's Nonprofits (RAN) grant application is under review by the US Department of Energy
- NYS CFA grant application will be submitted
 - Requested CFA matching funding from 2 Ots Co foundations
 - Submitting additional requests to 2 more foundations in November
- c. Appeal (\$2,300) + Mohawk Valley Gives (\$1,400) Campaigns raised approximately \$3,700

- d. Online Auction Planning
 - The Association has a Yeti cooler worth approximately \$400. Andrew suggested that Board members seek donations of other "outdoor" and spring/garden items; plenty of time to gather donations before Spring. The ideal timeframe may be April (before summer starts)
 - Use an online action platform (like 32auctions.com), run it for 2 weeks
 - Can bring credit card processing in house
 - Gives plenty of time to promote (Connections, social media, seed swap)
 - Auction relates to Strategic Plan objectives, refresh committee is another step
