Where Birds and Maple Meet: Inside Audubon's Bird-Friendly Maple Program

January 14th - Join Claire Mann (Audubon NY) and Rosa Goldman (Audubon CT) as they discuss [Audubon's Bird-Friendly Maple Program](#). The Bird-Friendly Maple Program aims to support maple producers and forest managers in creating and maintaining high-quality forest habitat for forest breeding birds while sustaining productive maple operations. This webinar will provide an in-depth introduction to the Bird-Friendly Maple Program, including its purpose, guiding principles, and how it fits within Audubon's broader forest bird conservation efforts. Participants will learn about the key habitat conditions the program seeks to achieve through forest management, such as complex forest structure and species diversity. We will discuss how bird-friendly practices can be integrated into maple forest management to promote healthy, resilient forests that benefit wildlife and producers alike. The webinar will also walk through how interested producers can enroll in the program. Attendees will gain clarity on eligibility, what participation involves, and how to connect with program staff.
