Access

Parking is available at a marked scenic overlook on Finkle Road, just off NY 28 south of the town of Andes. The GPS coordinates of the parking area is N42 11.710 W74 44.605.

The access trail travels 0.6 miles from the parking area, which takes hikers to an old farmstead. There is an Upper Meadow Loop Trail of 1.0 miles and the Lower Meadow Loop Trail of 1.5 miles.

The Trail:

The trail loops through open meadows with beautiful views of forested lands, apple trees and historic stone walls. It passes over Bryant's Brook and also features excellent views of many of the Catskill High Peaks, including Balsam, Eagle, Doubletop, Graham, Balsam Lake, and the Dry Brook Ridge. There is an interpretive sign to assist you in identifying the peaks.

This trail offers some breathtaking views, extensive stone walls and old foundations, and tons of open sky.
